Schooling Show Letterman Jacket Program

Purpose: To award the student enrolled in school that is an equestrian athlete for their perseverance in their riding endeavors. This program wishes to acknowledge these Young Riders' hard work and Achievements throughout the levels.

Categories

- Schooling Show Dressage: Introductory Level through Second Level
- Schooling Show Combined Training: Amoeba through Training
- Schooling Show Eventing: Amoeba through Training

Qualifications

- 1. Applicant must be a current GDCTA member at the time that the scores are earned.
- 2. Applicant is a Young Rider; age 22 or under as of December 31 of the year scores are earned.
- 3. Applicant is currently enrolled in school/college with a **minimum of a B or 3.0 grade average**. Proof of enrollment in school and grades are required. (i.e., report card)
- 4. Applicant must volunteer 8 hours at any non-profit, horse show, etc. Note that hours volunteered at GDCTA **Hosted** events will count double hours.
- 5. Scores will be collected through the GDCTA show season which runs from October 1 September 30 each year.
- 6. Dressage Requirements:
 - a. Four scores achieved at any two GDCTA recognized schooling shows from two different judges.
 - b. Qualifying scores are as follows:
 - i. Introductory Level: Minimum scores of 66%
 - ii. Training Level: Minimum scores of 65%
 - iii. First Level: Minimum scores of 64%
 - iv. Second Level: Minimum scores of 63%
- 7. Combined Training Requirements:
 - a. Two Scores achieved from any two GDCTA recognized events.
 - b. Qualifying scores are as follows:
 - i. Completed event with no Eliminations, Retirements, MR's etc.
 - ii. Amoeba: Maximum score 34
 - iii. Tadpole/Starter: Maximum score 34
 - iv. Beginner Novice: Maximum score 35
 - v. Novice: Maximum score 36
 - vi. Training: Maximum score 42
- 8. Eventing Requirements:
 - a. Two scores achieved from any two GDCTA recognized events.
 - b. Qualifying scores are as follows:
 - i. Completed the event with no Eliminations, Retirements, MR.s, etc.
 - ii. Finished scores are with zero cross country jump faults. (Time faults are allowed.)
 - iii. Amoeba: Maximum score 34
 - iv. Tadpole/Starter: Maximum score 34
 - v. Beginner Novice: Maximum score 35
 - vi. Novice: Maximum score 36
 - vii. Training: Maximum score 42
- 9. Double Threat Requirements: Achievements earned in both Dressage and Eventing (CT excluded). *Does not have to be earned in the same year.*
